Secretary's Report: M/S/C to approve the June 2024 meeting minutes as presented

Treasurer's Report:

- Special Funds balances reflect some payments/receipts for the Drive-In Diner fundraiser. Christian Counseling Funds were moved into Special Funds balance and the separate account was closed.
- June shows a net loss of \$22,223, with a total net loss year to date of \$70,350.
- June offering was lower than normal based off previous years' trends, but we currently still have an increase in YTD giving over last year's giving by .98% or \$3,898.21.

Church in the World (Jan and Connie)

- Sponsorship money to Guy and Leia Johnson is paid up through three quarters, but they will no longer serve with CRU, so the last quarter allocation will be distributed elsewhere.

Old Business:

P2FT Update:

- Interviewed a couple of fundraising firms. Cost to run a capital campaign is around \$60,000. The team has decided to organize a campaign on our own without the help of a consultant.

New Hope Mission Society Update:

- Faith Lutheran was a founding member, formed to help K.K. and now his son, Abdul Messiah.
- NHMS is low on funds and would like to raise awareness of its work, hoping to raise more support.
- Abdul Messiah is scheduled to be back in the area this fall.

New Business:

Sabbatical stay for Brazilian Pastor

- Juliano and Fabi Peter will enjoy some rest and relaxation at the Ansgar House, with the opportunity to learn more about Faith Lutheran and us about them. They will arrive on August. 13 and stay with us until the beginning of October. They will then spend six weeks with Shepherd of the Valley Lutheran Church in Afton, MN.

Special Funds is a collection of gifts designated for specific purposes. Some of those purposes are no longer active or have been sitting unused for years. The Management Team proposed disbursing some of those designated funds as follows:

- \$459.81 bequest from an estate that does not have a designation; put into the endowment fund.
- \$1,000 originally given to build the Blessing Box, but that expense was covered by the person who built it. Use the funds to purchase food to refill the box every month for as long as it lasts.
- \$320.31 from Cans of Hope. Use to help fill and ship shoe boxes for Operation Christmas Child.
- \$86.71 in decorating fund. Moved to Building Maintenance and Repair fund.
- \$513 from Mugs & Muffins and Men of Faith. Mention availability to discipleship team if needed.
- \$123 from Pictorial directory. Hold for next directory and use then.
- \$4,000 designated for roof repair. Use to pay for redoing the ceiling in the gathering space.
